WW1 Memorial is made of Blackwood in the “cupboard” style (wall mounted). It contains the names of the fallen written on the insides of the two doors. Inside on the back of the memorial is the following inscription written in red ink with black:

Greater Love Hath
No Man Than This
The Heroic Dead

On the top of the memorial the following is inscribed:
