4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Provision of Boat Ramp & Removal Concrete Weir

Council's Works & Infrastructure, Mr Chellis will prepare a plan for a boat
ramp at Cressy—matter to be circulated to the Committee when received.

Proposed Skate Park at Cressy

Cr Goss to liaise with Mr Nick Mackinnon about this proposal.

Re-Painting of Power Poles

Council's Works & Infrastructure Manager, Mr Wayne Chellis has requested
that the matter be placed on hold pending resolution to OH&S concerns.

It was **RESOLVED** that Mr Chellis be invited to establish a temporary work
station at a selected site so that work place safety issues can be displayed to
the volunteer who expressed an interest to undertake the required work.

It was requested that a letter be sent to Mrs Burton of 113 Main St, Cressy thanking her for her interest to re-paint the poles (those already painted) at Cressy--- project expected to commence in September/October 2013.

New Barbecue at Cressy

Mr Harwood advised that the plan was finalised and construction to be July 2013.

Reference was made to the presence of the large gazebo in the reserve—matter to be considered at a future meeting.

5. GENERAL BUSINESS

2013/2014 Works Budget

Mr Harwood circulated a copy of the 2013/2014 capital works program for Cressy.

Other minor works for the township of Cressy was mentioned by Cr Goss—Mr Harwood advised that a plan was being prepared that would show work required and expected date of completion.

Cr Goss circulated a Project Development Plan for Cressy The initiative comprised of works as follows:-

Town Hall

Painting of a mural on front wall of hall showing location of farms and various types of workers, a TV display and presence of images from 2012 Cressy History Day to be on Council's web site and also the display of historic agricultural machinery and the silhouette of a farm hand working the machinery.

Town Entrances

A scene of rural people working

Park

Display Board highlighting a walking track around the town to prominent community assets which will be recognised by plaques or silhouettes on the location.

Historical Recognition

Use of silhouettes and plaques at various sites around the township

War Memorial

Development of a Green Walk (display of silhouettes depicting the return of the Green brothers after World War 11 and provision of a display board and map showing the names of soldiers who perished in the two wars. The display will be linked to plaques erected outside the residence or farms where they lived

It was **RESOLVED** that it be recommended to Council that the matter relating to the advancement of the Cressy History Project be referred to Council's Economic & Community Development Manager Ms Green so that investigations on preliminary costs can be obtained with an appropriate grant being sought in consultation with Cr Goss.

6 OTHER BUSINESS

Condition of Telstra Pits in Cressy

Concern was raised about the condition/stability of Telstra pits in Cressy

Mrs Cables/Mrs Taylor

That it be recommended to Council that Telstra be requested to undertake risk assessments of their pits located in the township of Cressy. It was noted that at several sites, the pits may only require earth to be re-instated from around the lid itself.—responsibility to be determined.

Repairs to Entrance Gate at Cressy Recreation Ground

Matter to be referred to Mr Chellis via Customer Request form.

Planter Boxes

Mr Goss advised that he had spoken with Mr Chellis about relocating a few of the containers to Cressy (ex Longford units). Suggestion was supported with flowers to be planted therein and be watered by nearby property owners
