### **i) Location of Proposed Bus Shelter at Cressy**

### **ii) Funding for Equipment Shed – Cressy Scouts**

Reference was made by Mr Chugg to a grant received from Tas Community Fund (\$5,000) and also a grant from Council (requested \$5,000 and allocated \$1,000)
